Admissions Appeals Information

The Provision Of Information To Parents In Infant Class Size Appeals (Primary Schools Only)

Section 4.12 of the School Appeals Code states that all admission authorities must provide parents with information on the limited circumstances in which an infant class size appeal can be upheld in order that they can make an informed decision about whether to submit an appeal. Please see *Schools Admissions Code 2012* on the school website.

Appeals Timetable

The School Appeals Code of Practice states that all admission authorities must set a timetable for organising and hearing appeals.

In addition, all admission authorities must publish their appeals timetable on their website by 28 February each year.

Previously, all admission authorities in Warrington have followed the timetable published by the local authority. This means that, in order to comply with the statutory requirements of the Code, admission authorities are advised to include a statement on their website confirming this and include a link to the Council's website so the timetable can easily be viewed by the parent/carer and general public.
