



The information below explains what homework your child will be required to complete each week.



Google Classroom

Your child will be completing their arithmetic homework through **Google Classroom**. If you have any problems accessing Google Classroom, please inform your child's teacher through the school office who will be able to provide online support and paper copies if needed.

English

- **Reading** – please aim to read at home **5** times a week. Children can write their book information in their reading records with a brief synopsis of what they have read or what they have found out (e.g. Cinderella went to the ball and danced all night with the prince but lost her glass slipper. Mount Everest is the tallest mountain in the world). Parents can also sign this book to show they have read to you. Your child will be encouraged to choose a book from our UKS2 library or they are welcome to choose a book or other text (magazine, article, sports event programme etc.) from home. Some children may also be given a recommended text by their teacher to read. **Your child's reading record should be in school every day so please ensure it is in their bag.**

Maths

- **Arithmetic** - your child will be given arithmetic style questions to answer online. They should complete these independently. Do not spend any more than 30 minutes on these questions, even if they are incomplete. This should be handed in/turned in online by Friday morning.
